Starters

Oysters - Casanova supposedly consumed 50 oysters each day to keep his libido in top form.

Tonight we offer a half dozen oysters served chilled on the half shell with fresh lemon wedges.

Forbidden fruit plate - Start your meal with succulent and sinful apple, ripe red pomegranate, grapes, and figs.

Soup/Salad Course

House Salad - Romaine lettuce with red and green pepper, red onions, radishes, and fresh mozzarella. Your choice of dressing - Ranch, Blue Cheese, Italian Vinaigrette, Russian

Garlic Salad - A mouthful of fresh garlic might not sound like the best start to a romantic evening, but garlic has long had a reputation as an aphrodisiac. Our Garlic salad has romaine lettuce tossed with our homemade SPICY garlic dressing, onions, parmesan cheese and Dawley house croutons.

Almond Soup - Almonds were known throughout antiquity for stimulating desire. Samson wooed Delilah with them. This soup is rich and thickly nutty, slightly honeyed, lifted to heavenly delight with the tart contrast of jewel-red raspberries.

Entree Course

Randy Rigatoni - Tender rigatoni tubes, arugula, pine nuts, onions, and prosciutto tossed in a garlic and white wine sauce with red pepper flakes and parmesan cheese, served with fresh baked garlic bread. (the prosciutto & parmesan are optional for vegetarians or vegans)

Surf & Turf - Get the best of both worlds. A bacon wrapped 6oz filet of beef tenderloin served along side a 4oz lobster tail with drawn butter for dipping. Fingerling potatoes, sauteed swiss chard, shallots & roasted garlic finish the plate.

Spiced Rack of Lamb - 1/2 pound 4 bone Rack of Lamb spiced, then pan seared and slow roasted in the oven. Served on a bed of tabbouleh with oven roasted tomatoes.

Dessert Course

Pistachio Ice Cream - The Queen of Sheba was convinced that pistachios were a powerful aphrodisiac and ordered the pistachio harvest of the best trees grown in Assyria to be used for her and her royal guests only. For you and your someone special we offer our very own special recipe for pistachio ice cream.
